


URQO MALBEC DEL MIRADOR

The florar nose features violets, lavender and undertones of plum and herbs. Lean for a Malbec, it has taut, finely-grained tannins that establish a juicy, compatc, mouthfeel. The 2021 is a well-crafted, sharp, modern Malbec.	

<b>91</b> PTS.	JAMESSUCKLING.COM T	This is a sleek and focused malbec that has aromas of hazelnuts chocolate, plums and nutmeg. Medium-to full-bodied, with tight, fine-grained tannins that provide tension. Drink now or hold.

# The 2023 Chardonnay Urqo was sourced from Los Chacayes in the Uco Valley. Partially aged (60%) in barrel, this yellow greenish wine offers aromas of lemon and pear, with a subtle hint of oak in the

		background. Fruit-forward, its creamy palate and rich mouthfeel contribute to a concentrated flow. This is a well-crafted, commercially appealing white.
