The 2023 Sauvignon Blanc Palo Santo hails from the Uco Valley. Yellow in hue. The nose features lime and lemongrass notes along with hints of mint and ripe grapefruit over a layer of grass. Indulgent, intense and refreshing, with a taut malic acidity, citrus notes linger at the end. This is a satisfying, fairly compact white meant to be enjoyed young.

The 2021 Malbec del Mirador hails from Tunuyán and was 30% aged for up to nine months in oak barrels. Purple in hue. The florar nose features violets, lavender and undertones of plum and herbs. Lean for a Malbec, it has taut, finely-grained tannins that establish a juicy, compatic, mouthfeel. The 2021 is a well-crafted, sharp, modern Malbec.

Deep purple in color, it reveals delicate notes of violet, plum and wood. Fairly structured in the palate, it is juicy with balanced acidity and flavor. This a crowd-pleasing wine with a flavorful palate.

## URQO CHARDONNAY DEL MIRADOR

Picked in two stages to add extra layers to the resulting wine, this is an impressive, limited production Chardonnay from Los Chacayes. Fermented in stainless steel and 60% new wood, it has appealing layers of citrus, tangerine and nougat, subtle wood spices and a core of refreshing minerality. Worth keeping an eye on.

The 2023 Chardonnay Urqo was sourced from Los Chacayes in the Uco Valley. Partially aged (60%) in barrel, this yellow greenish wine offers aromas of lemon and pear, with a subtle hint of oak in the background. Fruit-forward, its creamy palate and rich mouthfeel contribute to a concentrated flow. This is a well-crafted, commercially appealing white.
